---

Marcus Dreisigacker is an artist who sets off on the search for meaning, context and the interaction between nature, life, death and resurrection without applying traditional structures of thought. From his observations in nature and life itself, he creates extraordinary images filled with new ideas.

It is as if he had fixed notion of how the networks and rules of nature function. He recognizes the interaction between the organic and the inorganic. As if able to feel the resulting turbulence, he seems to possess the ability to control and to transform it. Thus integrated, organic structures arise from the tiniest of individual parts; like a swarm, they reveal something other than the sum of their parts.

Open to coincidence, he integrates the randomness of movement and increases its rhythm until a new, fixed form arises that is both harmonious and rich in tension. With his uniqueness and powers of imagination, he creates new, strange-looking yet familiar worlds.

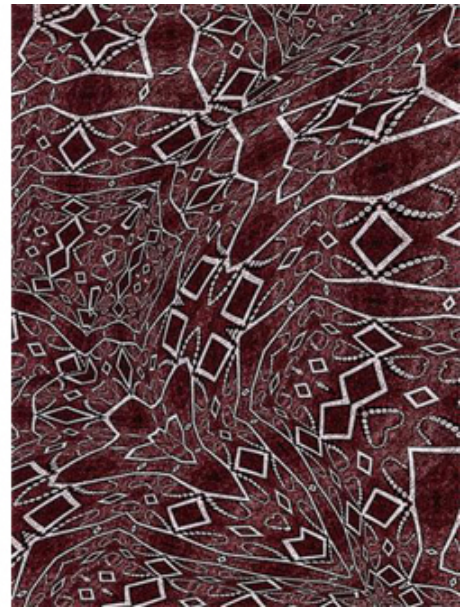

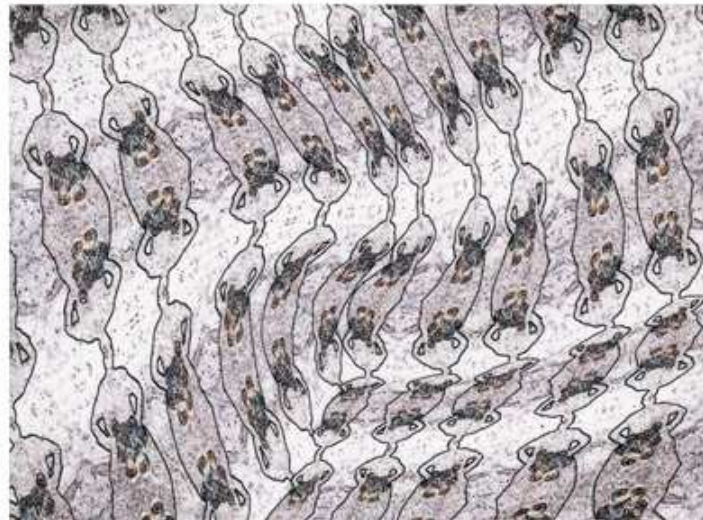

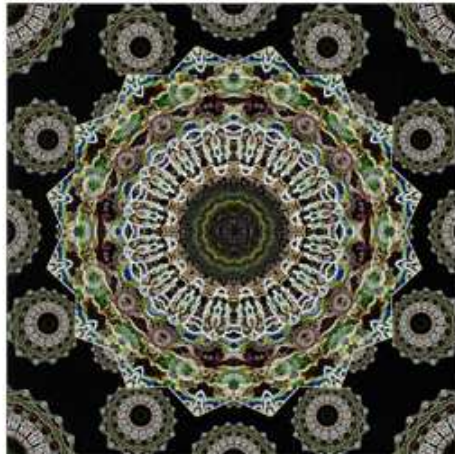

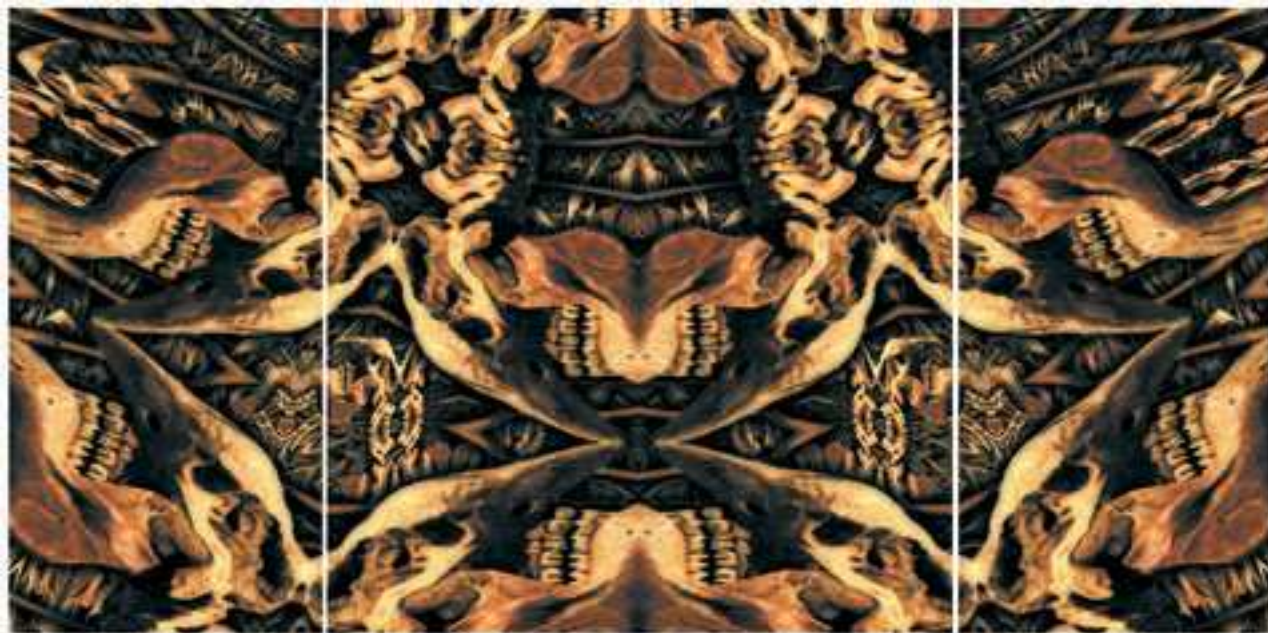
